## ASSIGNMENT of OIL & GAS LEASES

### Hill Lease:

An oil and gas lease from Dusty L. and Joni R. 

It is the intent of the Parties to convey 100% of the working interest of each Lease to the Assignee, free from any adverse claims or encumbrances. Assignor warrants it assigns Assignee 100% working interest in each Lease and each Lease is a valid Lease. Assignor agrees to indemnify Assignee for the payment of Lease royalties and / or income to any interest owner, wherein Assignor was responsible for such payments to interest holders while Assignor was Lease owner and operator. The assignment is made subject to the Parties' Lease Purchase Agreement, dated December 1, 2017.
