Affiant further states, Steve Knoll, Thomas Knoll and Patricia Knoll entered into an Oil and Gas Lease, dated March 28, 2014, filed in Book 266, Page 735 (hereinafter "Lease"), granting Anderson Exploration, LLC the right to explore and develop the above-described land. Anderson Exploration, LLC and its successors and assigns (hereinafter "Lessee") have failed and neglected to comply with the terms of the Lease. The facts constituting the Lessee's failure are as follows:


- (1) The Lessee has not produced oil or gas on the Lease since January 2016.
- (2) The Lessee has failed to produce oil or gas in paying quantities since January 2016.
- (3) The Lessee used water from the wells of the Lessors without permission.

Affiant further states, that because of the enumerated Lessee failures as outlined above, the Lease has been forfeited and is void.
