

MAP OF FINNEY AND GRAY COUNTIES, KANSAS

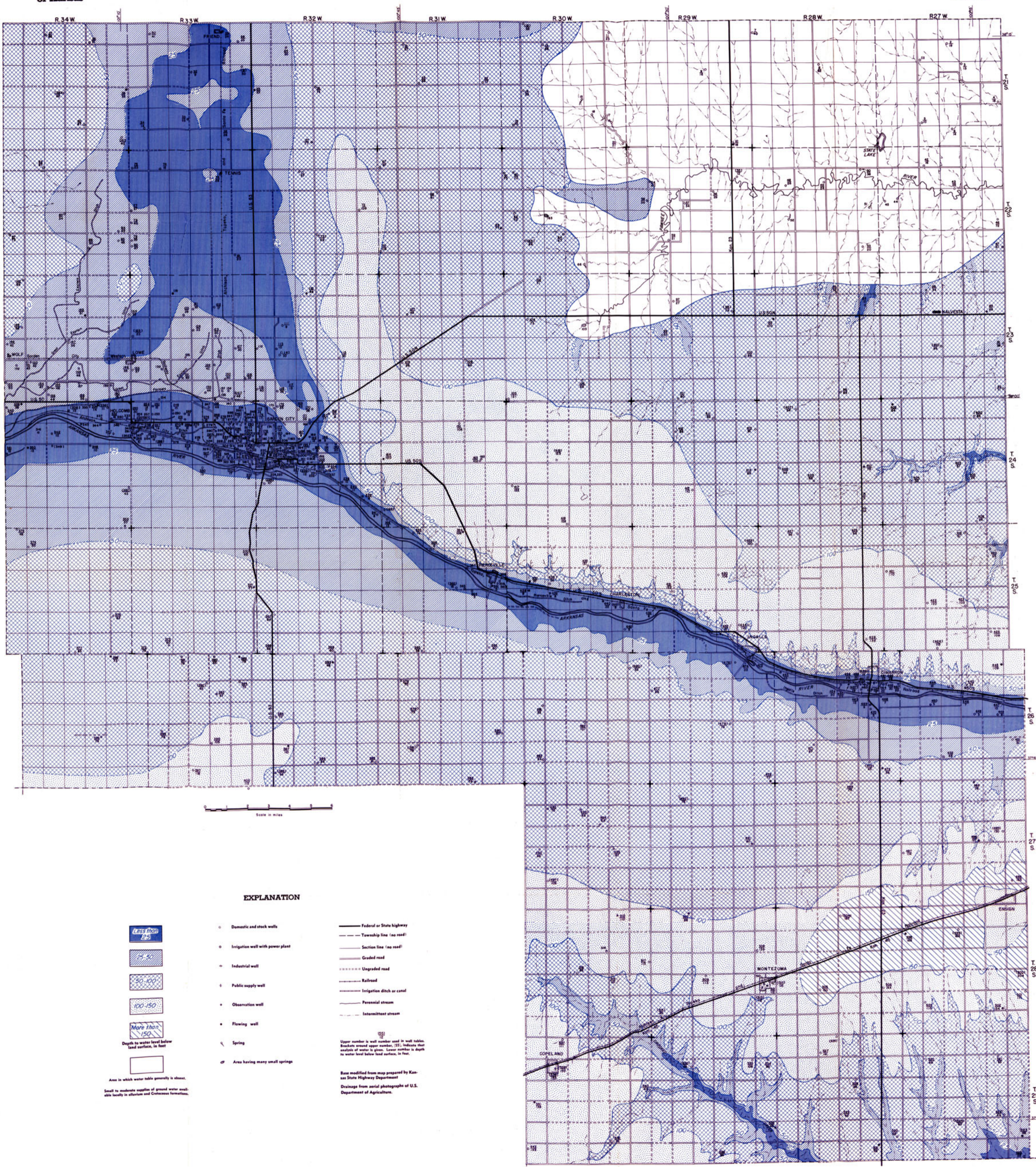
