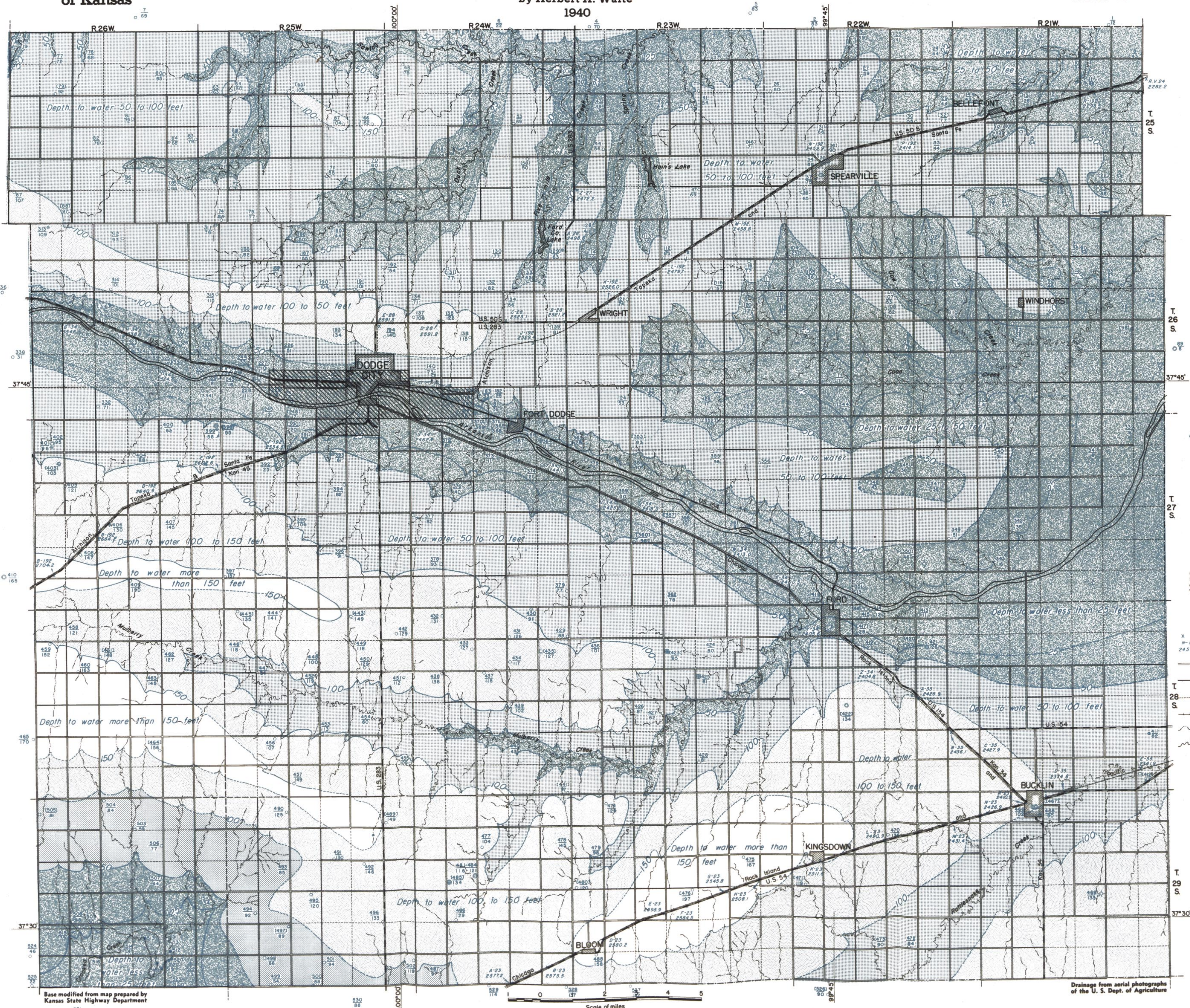


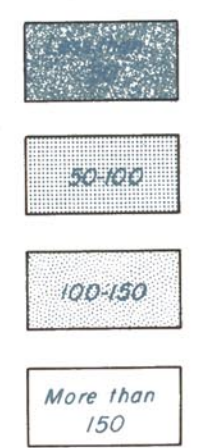
# MAP OF FORD COUNTY
