of Wells for Which Records Are Given

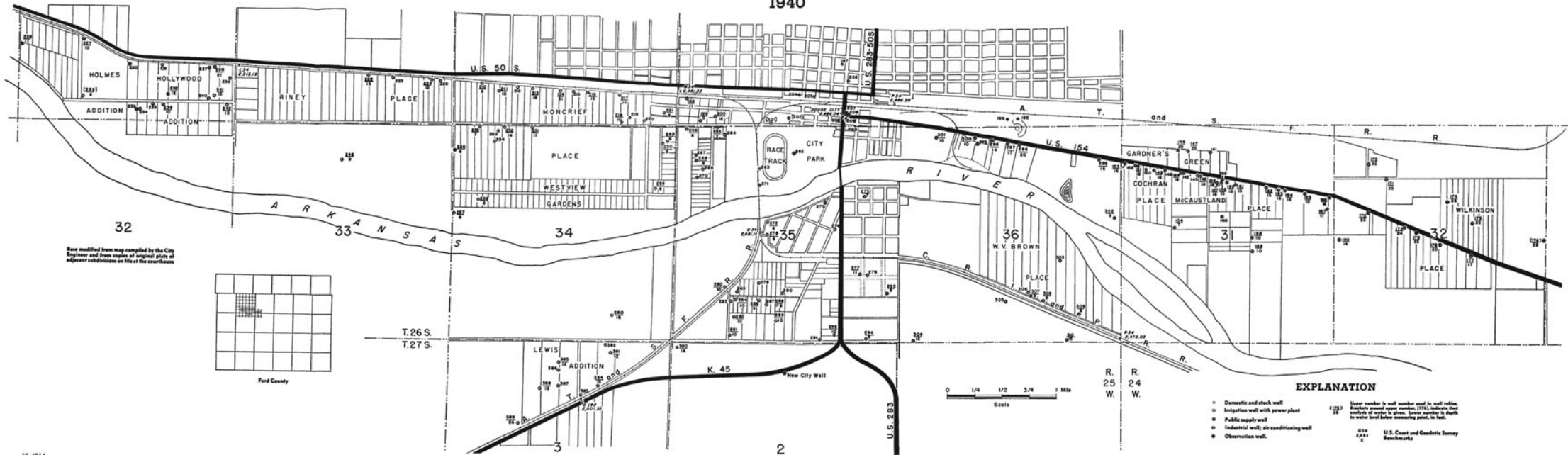

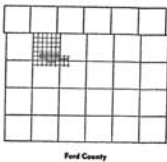
