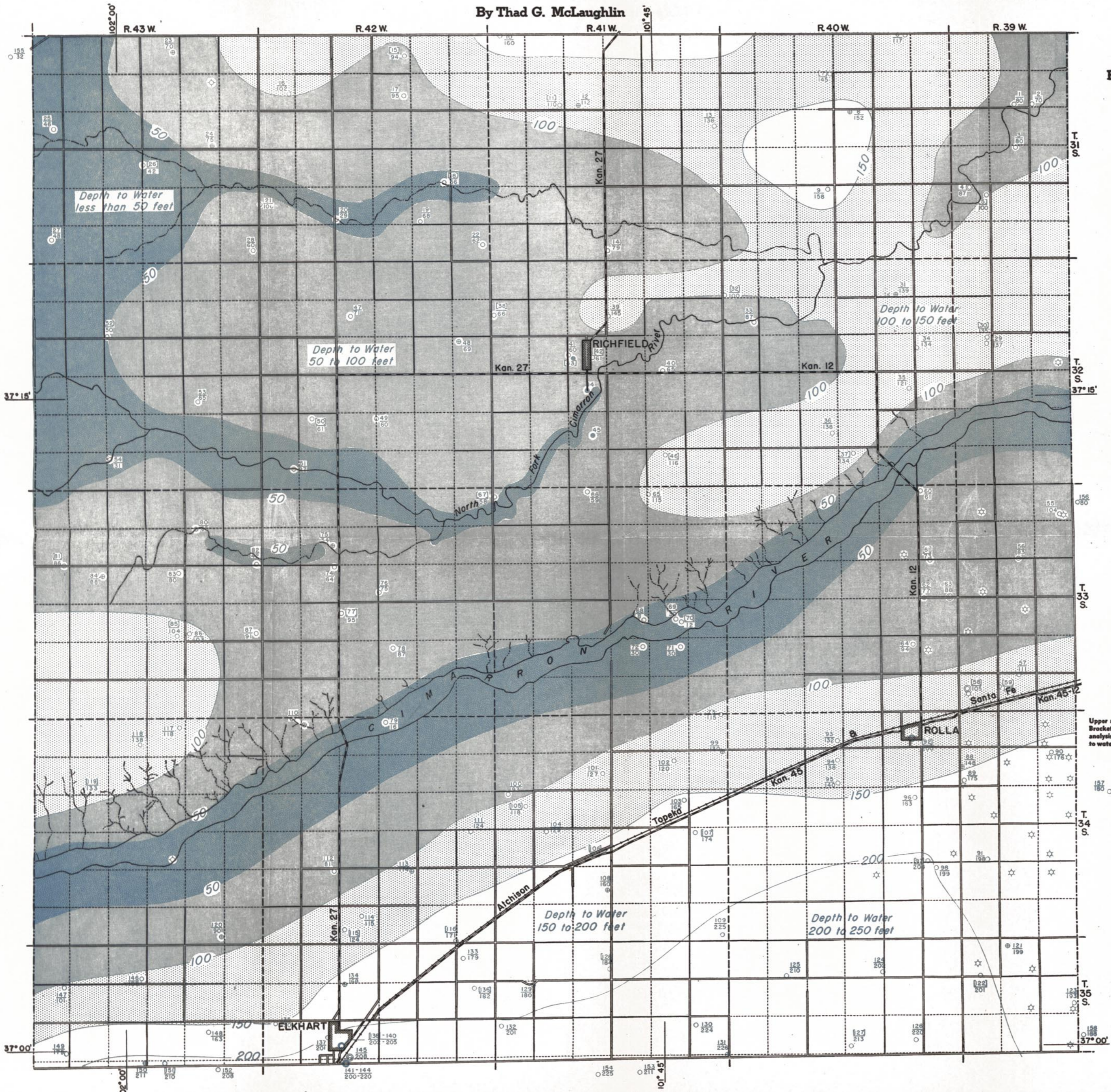

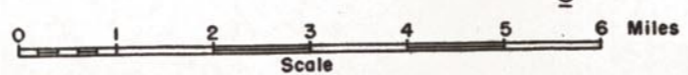
Depths to water level below land surface, in feet.
