

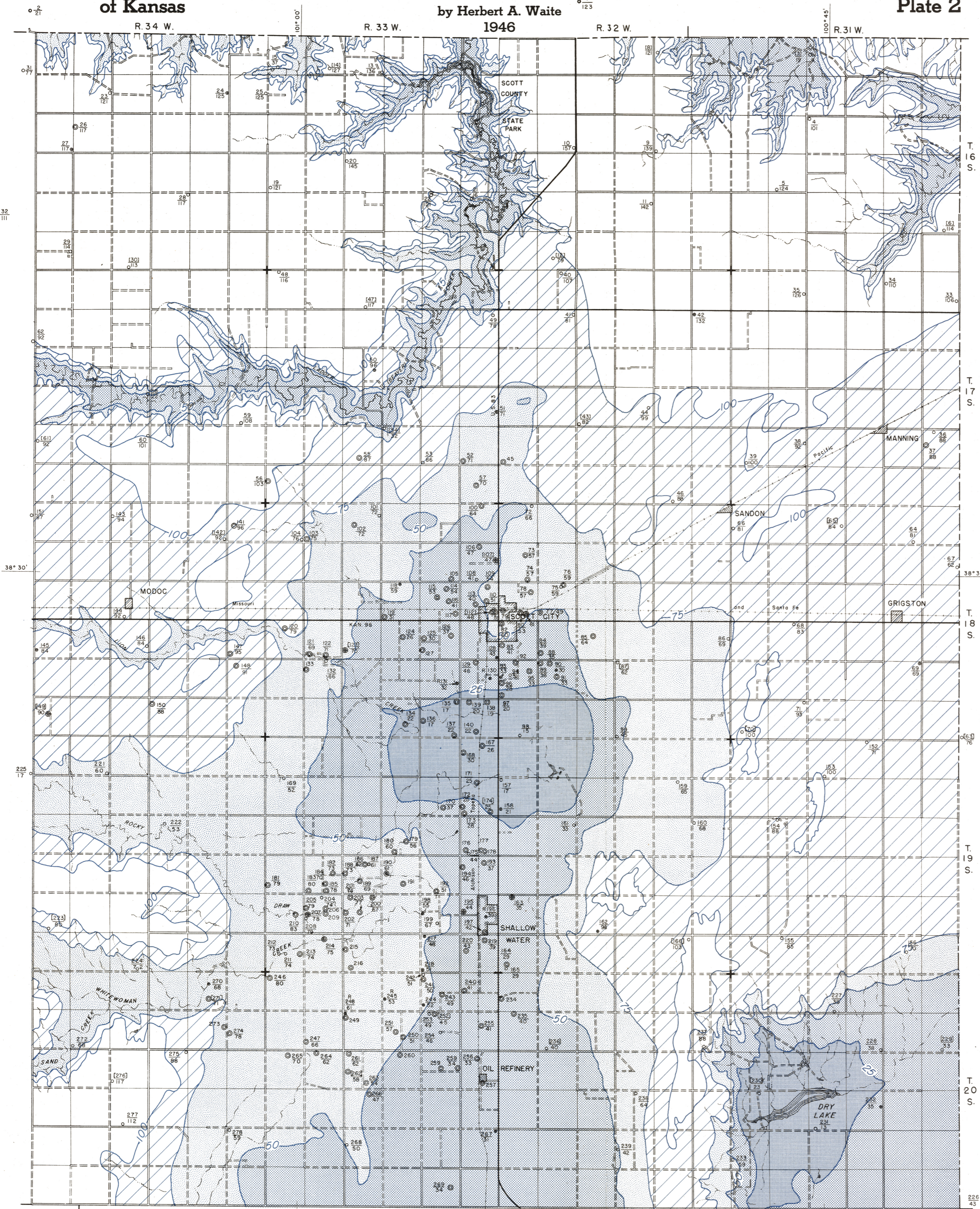
MAP OF SCOTT COUNTY

of Wells for which Records are given

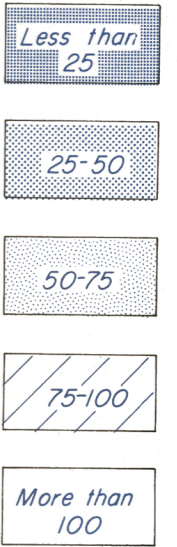
