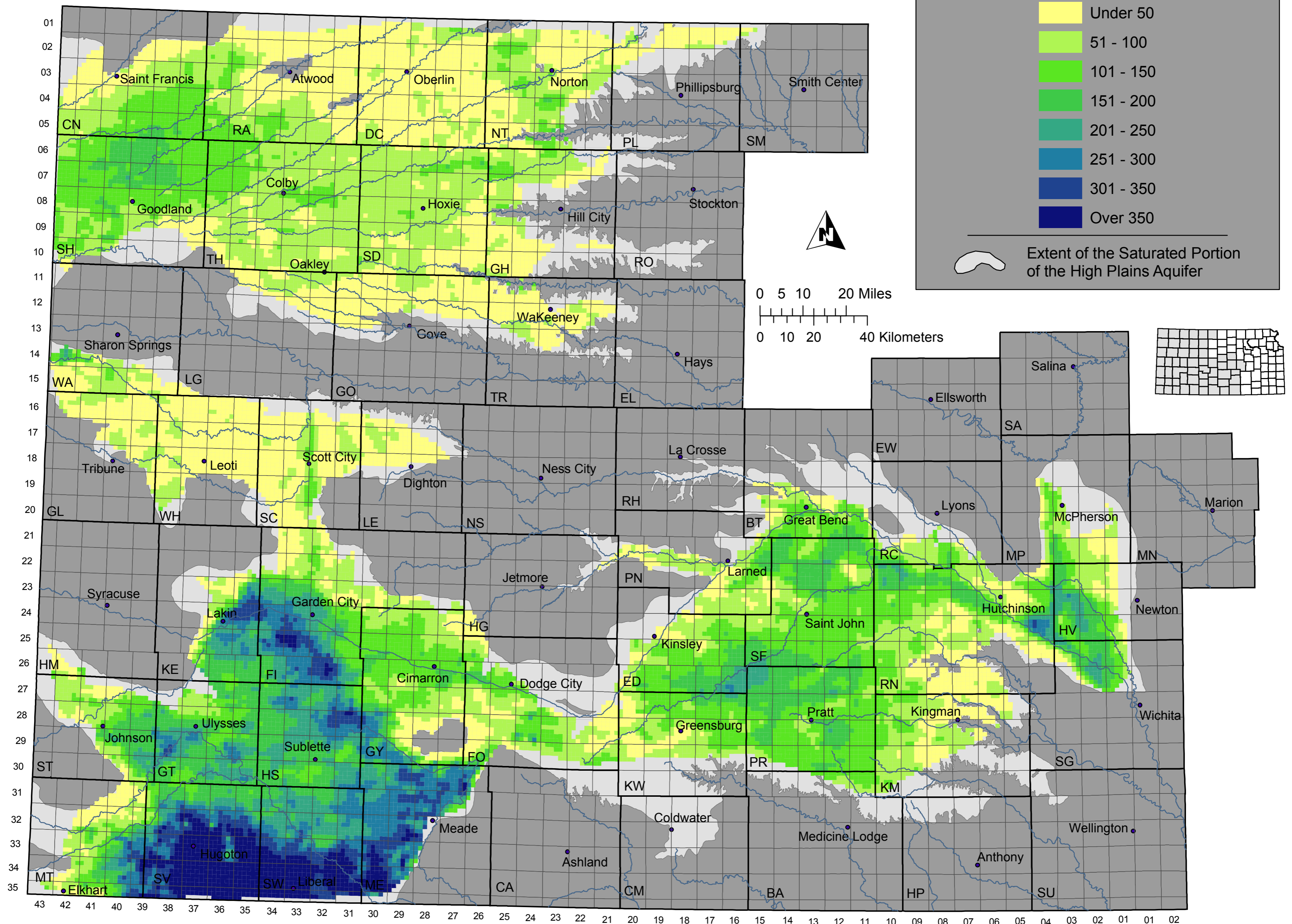


# Average 2003 - 2005 Saturated Thickness for the High Plains Aquifer in Kansas
