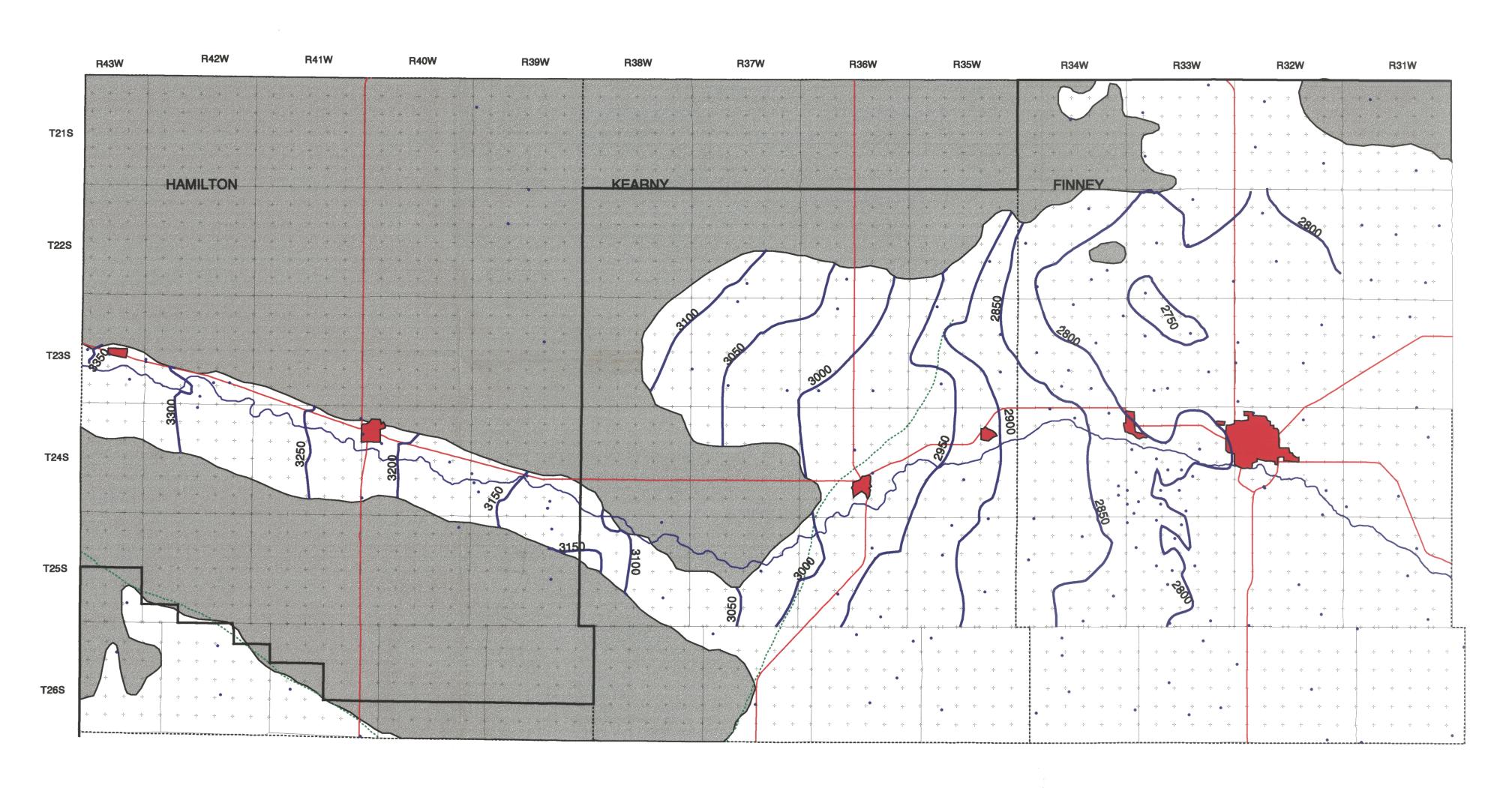

Water-level data are from the Kansas Geological Survey, the Division of Water Resources, and Groundwater Management District No.3

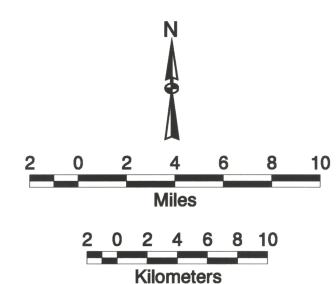

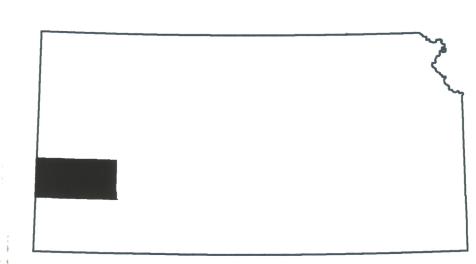
