SALTWATER DISPOSAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Lois Ferm Trust, Lois Ferm, Trustee, hereinafter referred to as "Grantor", is the owner of the following described real estate, hereinafter referred to as the "Premises" in McPherson County, Kansas, to wit:

The East Half of the Northwest Quarter (E2 NW4) of Section 5,Township 17S, Range 3W McPherson County. Kansas

AND Casebeer, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Grantee" produces saltwater from leases located in the area and wishes to dispose of said saltwater into the existing well on the Premises known as the Ferm #1, the following agreement is hereby made:

SO, NOW, in consideration of one (1) dollar and other valuable considerations and the payments to be made hereunder, the Grantor lets and the Grantee takes the premises for a saltwater disposal well to be used by the Grantee for disposal of saltwater under the following conditions:

- 1. Grantee agrees to operate this disposal well in a professional and businesslike manner and in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations.
- 2. The area covered by this agreement is limited to the existing tank battery, road and well site, however, Grantee agrees to have the existing electric poles removed and to restore most of the existing tank battery site to farmable condition saving only enough room at the property line west of the existing tank battery to install a 2' wide gathering tank and build a safety dike around it.
- 3. Grantor grants Grantee the right to lay lines, set tanks, etc. on the Premises, as necessary, to facilitate delivery of saltwater fom Grantee's existing line to the disposal well.
- 4. Grantee will pay a one time connection fee of \$500.00 to Grantor when and if the well is made into a disposal and will pay Grantor to dispose in the well at an initial rate of \$300.00 per month to be paid monthly on the first day of each month that disposal is occuring.
- 5. Grantee agrees to pay for any damages to growing crops on the premises caused by Grantee's operations.
- 6. Grantee agrees to be liable for and pay for all costs and damages that are a result of its operations.
- 7. The terms of this agreement shall expire when mutually agreed by both parties that conditions no longer warrant the continued use of the well as a disposal.

- 8. The rental fee set forth in this agreement shall be re-negotiated and adjusted on the third anniversary of this agreement and every three years thereafter as long as this agreement is in effect but will never be below the original amount set forth above.
- 9. The articles and covenants hereof shall extend to and bind the heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
