REGISTER OF DEEDS

OIL AND GAS LEASE

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 28th day of November, 2022, between Walter L. Moore and Linda L. Moore, husband and wife, (hereinafter called lessor) and Bull Oil Company, LLC (hereinafter called lessee), does witness:

That lessor, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained to be performed by the lessee, has this day granted, leased, and let, and by these presents does hereby grant, lease, and let exclusively unto the lessee the hereinafter described land, for the purpose of carrying on geological, geophysical, and other exploratory work, including core drilling, and the drilling, mining, and operating for, producing, and saving all of the oil, gas, casinghead gas, casinghead gasoline, including all associated hydrocarbons produced in a liquid or gaseous form and including gas found in and produced from coal formations or coal seams and all zones in communication therewith, which gas is sometimes referred to as coal bed methane, coal seam gas or occluded gas and all other gases and their respective constituent vapors, (including coalbed methane gas, helium, and all other constituents and substances produced therewith), including the dewatering for production of coalbed methane gas, and for constructing roads, laying pipe lines, building tanks, storing oil, and erecting other structures thereon which are necessary or convenient for the economical operation of said land to produce, save, take care of, and manufacture all of such substances, said tract of land with any reversionary rights therein being situated in the County of Chautauqua, State of Kansas, and described as follows:

The Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 13 East, Chautauqua County, Kansas,

Containing 160 acres, more or less.

- 2. This lease shall remain in force for a term of two (2) years from the date hereof, and as long thereafter as oil, gas, casinghead gas, casinghead gasoline, or any of the products covered by this lease are or can be produced.
- 3. The lessee shall deliver to lessor as royalty, free of cost, on the lease, or into the pipe line to which lessee may connect its wells, the equal three-sixteenths (3/16ths) part of all oil produced and saved from the leased premises, or at the lessee's option may pay to the lessor for such three-sixteenths (3/16ths) royalty the market price for oil of like grade and gravity prevailing on the day such oil is run into the pipe line or into storage tanks.
- 4. The lessee shall pay to lessor for gas produced from any oil well and used by the lessee for the manufacture of gasoline or any other product as royalty three-sixteenths (3/16ths) of the market value of such gas at the mouth of the well. The lessee shall pay to lessor for gas of whatsoever nature or kind (with all of its constituents) and all other substances covered hereby

sold by lessee, a royalty of three-sixteenths (3/16ths) of the net proceeds realized by lessee from the sale thereof, less a proportionate part of the ad valorem, production, severance and other excise taxes and any costs incurred by lessee in delivering, processing, compressing, transporting, dehydrating, or otherwise making gas or other substances merchantable with said payments to be made monthly, not more than sixty (60) days following the last day of the month in which gas is delivered into the pipeline and credited to lessee's account by the gas purchaser.

- 5. If Lessee shall commence to drill a well or commence reworking operations on an existing well within the term of this lease or any extension thereof, the Lessee shall have the right to drill such well to completion or complete reworking operations with reasonable diligence and dispatch, and if oil or gas, or either of them, be found in paying quantities, this lease shall continue and be in force with like effect as if such well had been completed within the term of years first mentioned. Drilling operations or mining operations shall be deemed to be commenced when the first material is placed on the leased premises or when the first work, other than surveying or staking the location, is done thereon which is necessary for such operations.
- 6. In case said lessor owns a less interest in the above-described land, other than the entire and undivided fee simple estate therein, then the royalties and rentals herein provided shall be paid to said lessor only in the proportion which his interest bears to the whole and undivided fee. However, such rental shall be increased at the next succeeding rental anniversary after any reversion occurs to cover the interest so acquired.
- 7. The lessee shall have the right to use gas, oil, and water found on said land for its operations thereon, except water from the wells or ponds of the lessor. When required by lessor, the lessee shall bury its pipe lines below plow depth and shall pay for damage caused by its operations to growing crops on said land. No well shall be drilled nearer than 200 feet to the house or barn now on said premises, without the prior written consent of the lessor. Lessee shall have the right at any time during, and within six (6) months after the expiration of this lease, to remove all machinery, fixtures, houses, buildings, and other structures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove all casing. Lessee shall grade to the original level and restore the surface to its original condition, as nearly as practicable, within six (6) months after the expiration of this lease.
- 8. If the estate of either party hereof is assigned (and the privilege of assigning in whole or in part is expressly allowed), the covenants hereof shall extend to the heirs, devisees, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, but no change of ownership in the land or in the rentals or royalties or any sum due under this lease shall be binding on the lessee until it has been furnished with either the original recorded instrument of conveyance or a duly certified copy thereof or a certified copy of the will of any deceased owner and of the probate thereof, or a certified copy of proceedings showing appointment of an administrator for the estate of any deceased owner, whichever is appropriate, together with all original recorded instruments of conveyance or duly certified copies thereof necessary in showing a complete chain of title back to lessor to the full interest claimed, and all advance payments of rentals made hereunder before

receipt of said documents shall be binding on any direct or indirect assignee, grantee, devisee, administrator, executor, or heir of lessor.

- 9. If the leased premises are now or shall hereafter be owned in severalty or in separate tracts, the premises nevertheless shall be developed and operated as one lease, and all royalties accruing hereunder shall be treated as an entirety and shall be divided among and paid to such separate owners in the proportion that the acreage owned by each separate owner bears to the entire leased acreage.
- 10. Lessor hereby warrants and agrees to defend the title to the land herein-described and agrees that the lessee, at its option, may pay and discharge in whole or in part any taxes, mortgages, or other liens existing, levied, or assessed on or against the above-described lands and, in the event it exercises such option, it shall be subrogated to the rights of any holder or holders thereof and may reimburse itself by applying to the discharge of any such mortgage, tax, or other lien, any royalty or rental accruing hereunder.
- 11. If, after the expiration of the primary term of this lease, production on the leased premises shall cease from any cause, this lease shall not terminate, provided lessee (a) resumes production, (b) initiates operations for recompleting an existing well within sixty (60) days from such cessation or (c) initiates operations for drilling a new well within sixty (60) days from such cessations, and this lease shall remain in force during the diligent prosecution of such operations and, if production results therefrom, then as long as production continues.
- 12. Lessee may at any time surrender or cancel this lease in whole or in part by delivering or mailing such release to the lessor, or by placing same of record in the proper county. In case said lease is surrendered and canceled as to only a portion of the acreage covered thereby, then all payments and liabilities thereafter accruing under the terms of said lease as to the portion canceled, shall cease and terminate and any rentals thereafter paid may be apportioned on an acreage basis, but as to the portion of the acreage not released the terms and provisions of this lease shall continue and remain in full force and effect for all purposes.
- 13. All provisions hereof, express or implied, shall be subject to all federal and state laws and the orders, rules, or regulation (and interpretations thereof) of all governmental agencies administering the same, and this lease, shall not be in any way terminated wholly or partially, nor shall the lessee be liable in damages for failure to comply with, any of the express or implied provisions hereof if such failure accords with any such laws, orders, rules, or regulations (or interpretations thereof). If, during the last six months of the primary term hereof, lessee should be prevented from drilling a well hereunder by the order of any constituted authority having jurisdiction there over, the primary term of this lease shall continue until six months after said order is suspended.
- 14. This lease and all its terms, conditions, and stipulations shall extend to and be binding on all successors of said lessor and lessee.

- 15. Lessee shall pay to lessor agreed surface damages prior to the commencement of drilling of any well on the leased premises, the sum of \$500.00, for all damages. Lessee shall pay to lessor agreed surface damages prior to the setting of any tank battery facility located on the leased premises, the sum of \$1,000.00, for all damages.
- 16. Lessee shall maintain all roadways used in its operations upon the leased premises in a good and workmanlike manner. Lessee agrees to consult with lessor concerning the location and route of any lease roads on the property (including the continuing use of any existing lease roads). Lessor agrees that they shall not unreasonably withhold their consent to the location and route of any such roads. Lessee agrees to use only one (1) road to each well site.
- 17. Lessee agrees to fence around all pump jacks and tank battery facilities so as to exclude livestock from such equipment and areas.
- 18. Lessee will cause the oil or gas purchaser(s) to pay directly to lessor the landowners' royalty interest.
- 19. Lessor shall be entitled to use free of cost, gas produced upon the leased premises by making their own connection at the wellhead at their sole cost and expense, for the principal residence of lessor. Lessor agrees to indemnify and hold lessee harmless from all damages, either to persons or property, suffered by lessors in the use of such gas. Lessor understands and agrees that the production of gas is intermittent and may be temporarily shut-in on various occasions. Lessor further agrees that lessee shall be under no obligation to treat or compress such gas so as to make it usable for residential purposes, and that the right of lessor to use gas free of cost obligates the lessee only to allow lessor to take any such gas produced "as is, where is, and with all faults and defects".
- 20. In constructing new wells, lessee shall set such amount of surface pipe as is necessary to protect sources of usable fresh water.
